Thesis/Claim (0-1pt.)</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">○</p>	<p>Responds to the prompt with a historically defensible thesis/claim that establishes a line of reasoning.</p>	<p><i>To earn this point, the thesis must make a claim that responds to the prompt, rather than merely restating or rephrasing the prompt.
